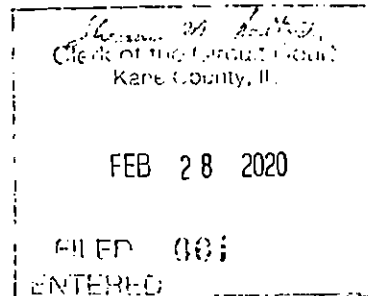

PETITION TO RESCIND STATUTORY SUMMARY SUSPENSION

NOW COMES the Defendant/Petitioner, Nathan Sweeney (DL# S500-6357-9274) by and through his Attorney, JOHN R. KOPP, and Petitions this Honorable Court to Rescind the statutory summary suspension entered against his Illinois Driver's License, and states the following in support thereof:

1) Petitioner was not properly placed under arrest for an offense as defined in 625 ILCS 5/11-501 of the Illinois vehicle Code (Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol/Drugs) or a similar provision of a local ordinance, as evidenced by the issuance of a Uniform Traffic Ticket to other form of charge;

2) The arresting officer did not have reasonable grounds to believe that Petitioner was driving or in actual physical control of a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol and/or other drugs, or a combination thereof;


3) Petitioner was not properly warned by the arresting officer as provided in 625 ILCS 5/11-501.1(c) of the Illinois Vehicle Code;

4) Petitioner did not refuse to submit to and/or complete the required chemical test or tests, pursuant to 625 ILCS 5/11-501.1 (d) of the Illinois Vehicle Code, upon the request of the arresting officer; and/or

5) Petitioner submitted to the requested test or tests but the test sample of my blood alcohol concentration did not indicate a blood alcohol concentration of 0.08 or more.

WHEREFORE, Defendant/Petitioner, Nathan Sweeney by and through his attorney, JOHN R. KOPP, petitions this Honorable Court to enter an order rescinding the statutory summary suspension of his Illinois Driver's License.
