## Narrative

### Possession of Stolen Vehicle Investigation

Beginning of Report by Detective Captain Bobby Wallace #785

On April 2, 2025, I received a call from [REDACTED] [REDACTED] indicated that she had a black GMC truck stolen from her late father's property located at [REDACTED] in Fairfield. She filed a report with the Wayne County Sheriff's Office on October 20, 2020. The vehicle was entered into LEADS as stolen at that time. She originally suspected her sister Michelle McKinney of stealing the truck.

During the conversation, she told me that she was in Nason today and she has pictures of the truck inside Michelle's garage. I asked her to e-mail me the photos. She also sent me a copy of the vehicle title clearly showing she was the owner of the vehicle.

Later that day, I received an e-mail from [REDACTED]. I inspected the image. The image shows a black GMC truck inside the northern most garage in the out building located south of the residence located at [REDACTED] in Nason. I recognized the garage in the image, I also looked garage in Google maps and verified it was in fact the same garage.

On April 15, 2025, I contacted Detective Kody Moore with the Wayne County Sheriff's Office. I requested a copy of the report involving the theft of this vehicle. I later received Wayne County SO Report #19620-00558. The vehicle was listed as stolen and has been entered into LEADS as stolen.

On April 15, 2025 at about 1108 hrs., I requested and was granted a search warrant to search the garage located at [REDACTED] in Nason for the vehicle.

On April 15, 2025 at about 1330 hrs., Detective Kristina Draege and I went to [REDACTED] Street in Nason to follow up on this and serve the search warrant.

Upon arrival, I met with Michelle, who was in the yard. I started by introducing myself. I spoke with her regarding other reports that she has made. I eventually told her that we had received information from her sister, [REDACTED], that there was a black GMC Truck stolen in Wayne County. I asked her if she knew anything about that. She said she did not know anything about that truck. I told her that I had been told that the truck was possibly inside her garage on this property. She said it absolutely is not and she would let us search if we wanted. She then went and opened the garage door. There was no truck inside the garage but I could see fresh vehicle tracks coming out of the garage as if a vehicle had been in there recently. I asked her if a black GMC truck has been inside this garage. She said no. I asked her if one had ever been in the garage. She said no. I warned her about making a false statements and if she did she could be arrested for Obstructing Justice. I asked her again if a black GMC truck had ever been in this garage. She said no. I then showed her the picture. She said that picture must have been altered.

At this point, I advised her she was under arrest for Obstructing Justice. I had Deputy Caroline Smith come to the scene and transport Michelle to the Justice Center so I could finish the investigation and process her on the charge.

There were two juveniles left at the residence. Detective Draege and I stood by

until [REDACTED], Michelle's boyfriend, could get here to be with the juveniles.

[REDACTED] arrived. I introduced myself and told him why we were here. I asked him about the black GMC truck. At first he lied and said there was no truck. When I warned him about providing a false statement, he eventually told us the truck was at the old coal mine building. He said he moved it over there a few days ago at the request of Michelle. He said he thought the truck belonged to her but knew there was some family drama over the vehicle.

[REDACTED] drove us over to the old coal mine building. He took us inside and I observed the described truck. I then ran the VIN number through dispatch. I was advised this was the vehicle and it was listed as stolen out of Wayne County.

The vehicle was drive able and the keys was in the vehicle. I drove the vehicle to the Sheriff's Office where it was secured.

I then met with Michelle in Interview Room 1. I attempted to do a follow up interview with her. She advised she had nothing to say to me.

I took her to the booking area. I booked her in for Possession of a Stolen Vehicle and Obstructing Justice. She was processed and later released with a Notice to Appear on May 22, 2025.

Who purchased the truck/when/where/by what financial means? How did the victim sister get the truck titled to her in October of 2010? Who was it titled to before that?

I e-mailed [REDACTED] with these questions. She responded with the following response:

The Truck was purchased I think at a GMC Dealership somewhere in NW Indiana, I am not sure where it was purchased. It was brand new and fully loaded. The cost was over \$60 K, that is a fact. I also know for a FACT; the Truck was purchased with cash by [REDACTED] then Registered under [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] ([REDACTED] was his wife at the time of purchase and at the time [REDACTED] passed).

The Original Title was unable to locate. Attached is a print out from the DMV showing the truck was registered to [REDACTED] at the time [REDACTED] passed.

Attached is [REDACTED] Death Certificate. Myself and [REDACTED] went to the DMV to have [REDACTED] name taken off of the Truck Title.

Attached is the new Truck Title that is in [REDACTED] only. Documented of the Transfer of Title to [REDACTED] at the bottom.

The State's Attorney of said County charges:

**COUNT I**

That on or about the 2<sup>ND</sup> day of April, 2025, in said County and State, **MICHELLE L. MCKINNEY** committed the offense of **UNLAWFUL POSSESSION OF STOLEN VEHICLE** in that said defendant, a person not entitled to possession of said vehicle, possessed a 2009 GMC 1500 truck titled to Melody Dispenza, knowing it to have been stolen or converted, in violation of 625 ILCS 5/4-103(a)(1), A **CLASS 2 FELONY**. (JCSO REPORT NO. S25-02562)

**COUNT II**

That between April 2, 2025 and April 15, 2025, in said County and State, **MICHELLE L. MCKINNEY** committed the offense of **OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE** in that said defendant, with the intent to prevent the apprehension of herself, knowingly concealed physical evidence in that Michelle McKinney asked Anthony Page to remove a certain 2009 GMC 1500 truck from her garage and hide it in another building, knowing the truck to have been reported stolen, and that the 2009 GMC 1500 was actually secreted away to another location by Anthony Page, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/31-4(a), a class 4 felony. **COUNT III**

That on or about the 15<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2025, in said County and State, **MICHELLE L. MCKINNEY** committed the offense of **OBSTRUCTING JUSTICE** in that said defendant, with the intent to prevent the apprehension of herself, knowingly furnished false information to Captain Bobby Wallace of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department, in that she advised Captain Wallace a certain 2009 GMC 1500 truck had not been in her garage, when in fact it had, in violation of 720 ILCS 5/31-4(a), a class 4 felony. I, Bobby Wallace, being first duly sworn deposes and says; That on the on or about the 2nd day of April, 2025, the felony crime to wit: Violation of Section(s) 625 ILCS 5/4-103 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes was committed by Michelle McKinney and [REDACTED] at at 352 N 3rd Street in Nason, Illinois; in the following manner, to wit: Possession of Stolen Vehicle.

I have an Associated Degree in Criminal Justice from Central Texas College and a Bachelor Degree in Criminal Justice Administration from Saint Leo's University.

I am a Certified Police Officer in the State of Illinois as certified by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board. I graduated from the Southwestern Illinois Police Academy in 2002.

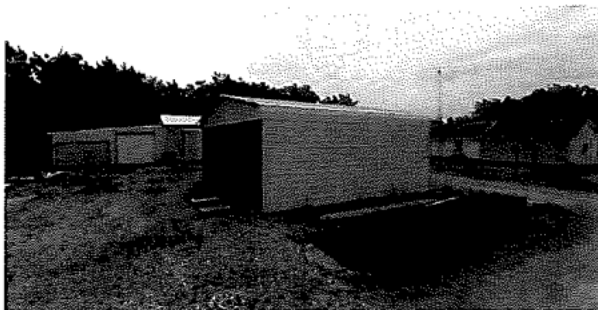
