ORDER

Change of plea hearing held on 11/21/2025. Defendant is informed of his rights. Defendant enters a plea of guilty to count 1 of the superseding indictment. Plea accepted, judgment of guilty entered. Case is referred to the Probation Office for a presentence investigation report. The Probation Office is directed to disclose its sentencing recommendation to the government and defense counsel. The preparation of the presentence report and sentencing date are deferred. Defendant's current bond to stand. A telephone status hearing is set for 3/9/2026 at 9:00 a.m. To join the telephone conference, dial (650) 479-3207, Access Code 180 815 7648. Throughout the hearing, each speaker will be expected to identify themselves for the record before speaking. Counsel must be in a quiet area while on the line. Please be sure to keep your phone on mute when you are not speaking. Persons granted remote access to proceedings are reminded of the general prohibition against photographing, recording, and rebroadcasting of court proceedings. Violation of these prohibitions may result in sanctions, including removal of court issued media credentials, restricted entry to future hearings, denial of entry to future hearings, or any other sanctions deemed necessary by the Court. The government's oral motion to exclude time as to counts 2 through 10 is granted without objection. Time is excluded through 3/9/2026.

Pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3664(d)(1), if restitution is being sought in this case, 60 days prior to the sentencing date, the Government shall provide the Probation Office and the courtroom deputy an electronic standardized spreadsheet (available on the Court's website) with a list of victims and their full current contact information. This list shall include any amounts subject to restitution. If the Government is not able to provide the full victim list 60 days prior to sentencing, they shall file a motion to request an extension of time to compile the information, to the extent permitted by 18 U.S.C. § 3664(d)(5).
