In the event there is a conflict between the terms of paragraph 17 below and a prior injunction order, visitation order or other court order, the terms of THIS ORDER MUST BE FOLLOWED if the Defendant remain on Pretrial Release. It may be necessary for the Defendant to obtain a modification of any other court order or visitation schedule to comply with that order AND these conditions of Pretrial Release. Nothing in this Order shall be construed to cancel, revoke, or otherwise alter the conditions of any other court order or injunction. Unless BOTH or ALL orders permit the defendant to have contact with the victim(s), CONTACT IS PROHIBITED. Pursuant to s.903.047, F.S., the following are the Defendant's conditions of pretrial release under the supervision of Pretrial Services:
